No horses or jockeys were harmed, but the riders momentarily began pulling up their mounts because of the danger... JOSE NAVA of Pacoima successfully picked winner Generations in the 8th race after his name was pulled in Friday's CashCall \$1,000 to Win Contest. He collected \$1,400 on the 2-5 favorite.... Santa Anita CEO Mark Verge will be the guest of Tim Conway Jr. tonight at 7 p.m. on KFI AM 640....Martin Garcia had a riding double Friday....Tomorrow's 23rd California Cup Day includes the \$175,000 Lava Man Cal Cup Classic presented by City National Bank. Leading the field to the post will be Lava Man, now 11 years old and a stable pony for trainer Doug O'Neill. His 2006 and 2007 victories in the Santa Anita Handicap contributed to his \$5.2 million career earnings....Also tomorrow, fans with paid admission will receive a Doug O'Neill Bobblehead, while supplies last....Tomorrow and Sunday are Pumpkin Patch Family Fun Days, with pony rides, face painting and other child-friendly attractions in the Infield ....Pepper, a three-member band, will be featured at the Party in the Paddock after the races tomorrow.
